Learning format

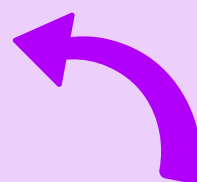
For each unit, practitioners will complete two hours of online self-study, and attend a total of seven facilitated webinars, led by our speech and language experts
