

Supporting Phase One Phonics through the curiosity and wonder of a box



Harness the mystery, suspense and magic of a box to support children in developing the auditory discrimination skills for phonics.

A box with a symbol, meaning 'Do Not Open' (unless, of course you have the password- a sound, a rhyming string, an alliterative phrase) developing memory - can you recall the password?

A box with a character that tells us a secret sound, or only wakes when we make a quiet sound with our body... a dinosaur that instructs us to be a slithering snake, a jiggling jellyfish or a galloping goat.

A box full of treasure- a penguin, a pickle, a parrot, a pea... each imaginary object given to a child then replaced as they recall what they were given.
